**Step 1:** start by dipping your hand into some red paint. Then press it down firmly onto a piece of A4 paper.



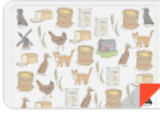
**Step 2:** Now use your orange and yellow crayons to add details to the hen. Add orange feathers and a yellow beak and tail. Your fingers are her wings.

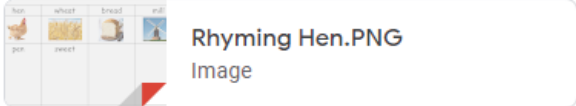

# Heavier and Lighter

Today we are learning to compare 2 objects by using the mathematical language- heavy, light, heavier and lighter. Ask your child to pretend that they are a bucket scale. Place 2 objects, heavy in one hand and light in the other, in hands. What would happen to the bucket scales? They would tip with the heavier object going down and the lighter object going up. Play with different objects and encourage your child to move correctly as bucket scales. Then complete the activities below. (Please don't worry if you can't print the activities- you can record work in any way you possibly can even if its just verbally to you. Children will still learn lots in this way.)

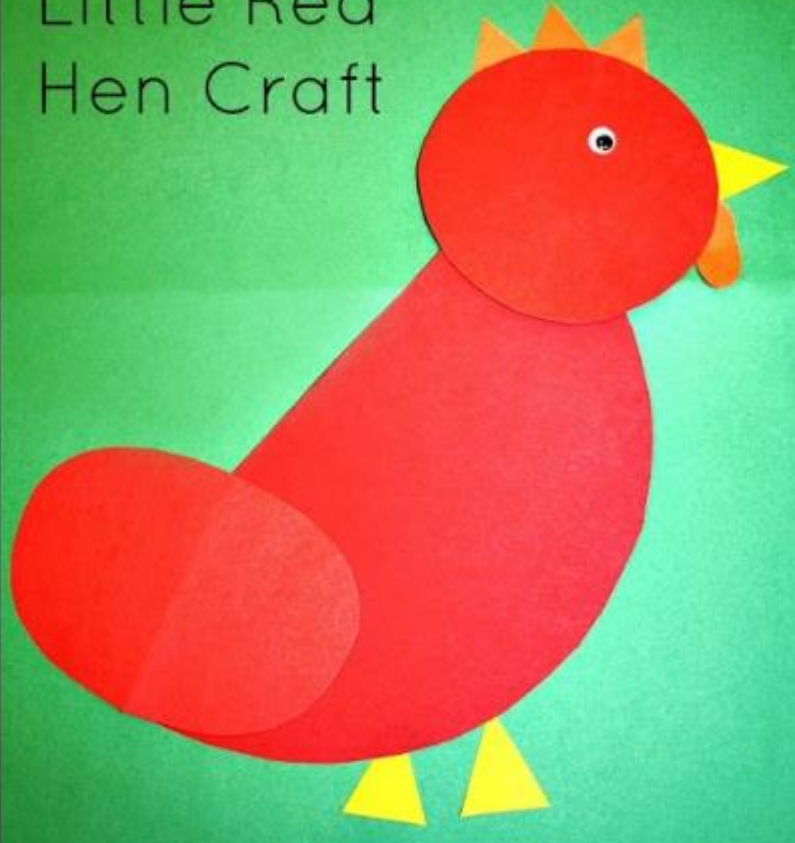

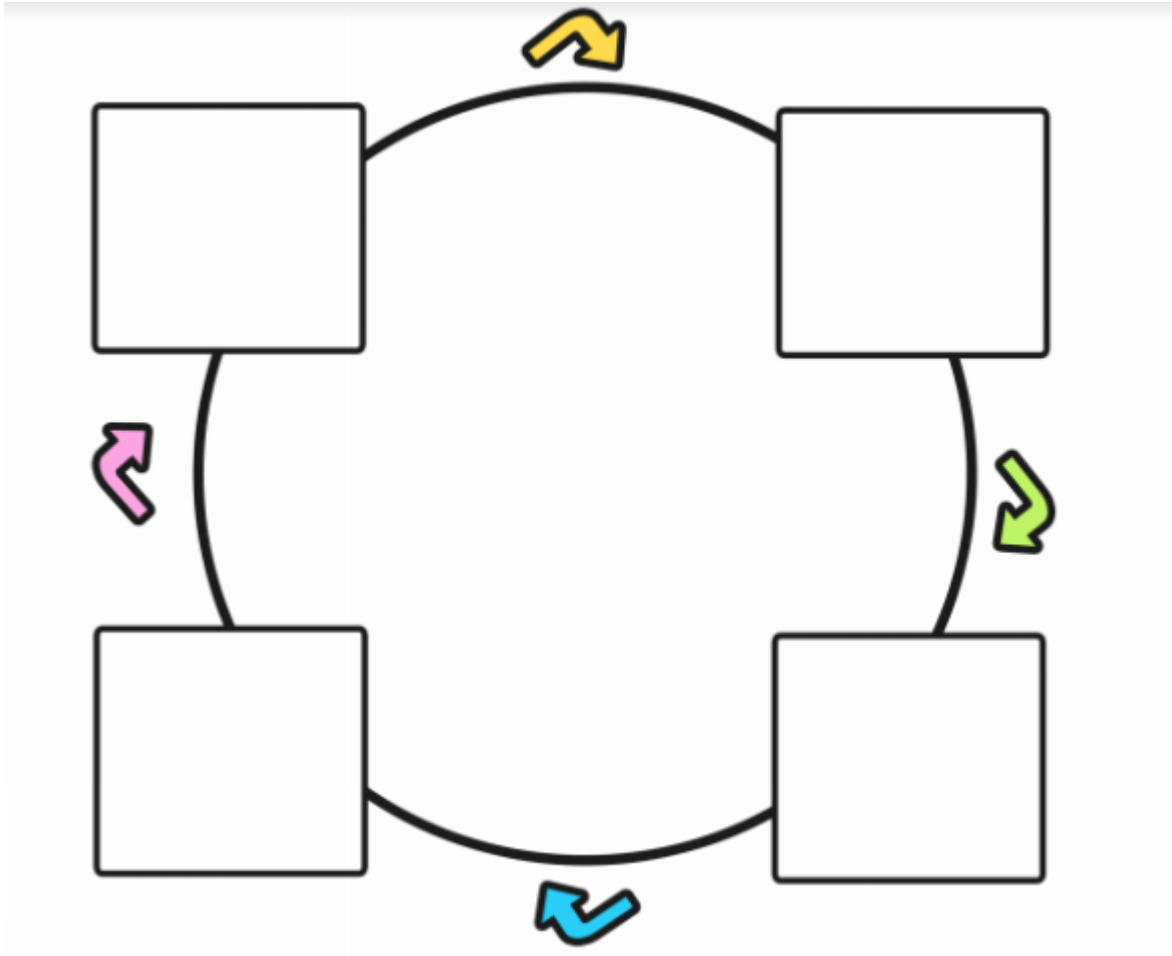


# Life Cycle of a Hen
