

QRA Curriculum SMSC



SMSC stands for spiritual, moral, social and cultural development.

SPIRITUAL

Pupils to explore beliefs and experience; respect faiths, feelings and values; enjoy learning about oneself, others and the surrounding world; use imagination and creativity and reflect.

MORAL

Pupils to recognise right and wrong, respect the law, understand consequences, investigate moral and ethical issues and offer reasoned views.

SOCIAL

Pupils to use a wide range of social skills, participate in the local community, appreciate diverse viewpoints, participate, resolve conflict and engage with the British values of democracy, the rule of law.

CULTURAL

Pupils to appreciate cultural differences and influences, appreciate the role of Britain's parliamentary system, participate in culture opportunities and understand, accept, respect and celebrate diversity.

Intent

At Queens Road Academy, we encourage children to be inquisitive, and curious about the world around them. Our schools overarching intent is for all of our children to experience a rich and balanced PSHE, SMSC and RSE curriculum. Our intention is that children will leave Queens Road Academy as rounded individuals with open minds, who are also equipped with the knowledge, understanding and skills they need to manage their lives now and in the future.

Implementation

Our curriculum is organised into 6 themes, which link to an aspect of our PSHE curriculum. This enables us to provide a consistent wider approach inside and outside of the classroom. These themes are Health & Wellbeing, Relationships, Global Citizenship, British Citizenship, Responsible Citizenship and Futures. We teach SMSC/PSHE in a variety of ways: via assemblies as well as through intergenerational visits, community groups and working with the local councillors. We use philosophy discussions and debates regularly, which promote communication and critical-thinking two of our key values. We also hold half-termly whole school events which link to our 6 key themes. For example, Health & Wellbeing Events and Cultural Diversity events. These are very well attended by our local community and families.
