If you are unable to register online, please contact our Customer Services team on 01226 773 555. It's important to register as soon as possible, as late applications cannot be accepted.

After you register, we'll contact you by text or email with full details about where and when to collect your good food box from a local site.

The boxes will be available from Tuesday 30 March. When collecting your box, please remember to follow the hands, face, space guidance. Social distancing measures will be in place, and you'll need to wear a face covering, or bring your proof of exemption and use hand sanitiser or wash your hands before and after visiting.
