

We Are The Champions- Year 3



Core Text:
 Splash!
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This unit of work focuses on the FIFA Football World Cup. Pupils will learn about the history of the tournament and use historical sources to find out about England winning the World Cup in 1966. Pupils will then look to the World Cup in 2022, which will be held in Qatar. They will find out about the country and its climate and consider the impact this might have on the athletes and the games. Pupils will then plan their own football tournament. They will design and make their own team kit in DT and in ICT they will code their own football game using Scratch. In PE, they will develop their football skills and train in teams in preparation for the end of topic tournament.

By the end of this unit, I will know:

- That every 4 years, football teams from around the world come together to take part in a football tournament and the first tournament happened in 1930.
- The first international football match was held between Scotland and England although the game was a little different then.
- There was not a tournament held in 1942 or 1946 due to World War 2.
- That England won the football World Cup in 1966.
- To play in the World Cup, teams have to compete against other teams in the same continent and earn a place.
- That the football World Cup in 2022 will be held in Qatar and that this decision has been controversial.

Key Geography Skills :

- Understand the term climate zone and use maps to identify the different climate zones.
- Locate different countries in the Northern/Southern hemispheres and discuss how life is different in the two hemispheres.
- Reason about key physical and human characteristics of regions

Key History Skills:

- Use their own sources to find out/infer relevant information about the past.

Key DT Skills:

- Add a fastening to products. e.g. sew on buttons and make loops.
- Understand the need for patterns.
- Use applique to decorate.

Key Computing Skills (Scratch):

- Start commands in different ways e.g. flag, messages, key press and button
- Animate a sprite by using change costume and repeat functions.
- Use conditional statements within the program to control the sprite.
- Detect and correct errors in algorithms as necessary.
