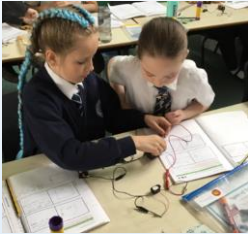


Our Values in Action Science

Resilience



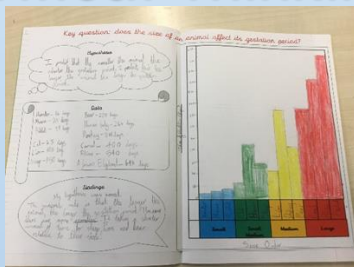

Innovation

Critical Thinking



These pupils explored the gestation periods of different animals and then hypothesised about the links between gestation periods and the size of different animals, before testing their theories.
